

Pre-Recital Jury Performance

Strings & Voice

Students:

At least three weeks before the date of a half or full recital, you are required give a pre-recital performance for a jury of three music faculty. If the members of the jury do not think that you will be ready by the date of your recital, then your recital will be delayed. You will perform at least 15 minutes of music at your pre-recital jury and the faculty members of the jury may choose any music from your recital program. The minimum program length for a senior degree recital (BA in Music or BME) is 30 minutes.

1. It is your responsibility to choose faculty members, and to choose a date for your pre-recital jury that will work for those faculty members. Your jury must consist of three members of the Wittenberg music faculty including at least one member of the full-time faculty (Durrenberger, Jones, Kazez, Schubert, Zinter) and your major teacher.
2. On or before the date of your pre-recital jury performance, send (to dkazez@wittenberg.edu) a high-resolution photo of yourself, with your instrument, that can be used for recital publicity.
