What Every Student Should Know:

- All Wittenberg Students get 1 Wellness Visit per school year which includes: basic health and wellness screening exam, basic vision screen, health risk appraisal, blood pressure reading, body mass index calculation, basic lab testing (cholesterol, blood sugar), review and education of results, annual flu shot (given at time of visit or during flu clinic).
- Up to 5 additional visits per student throughout the year when needed, to include in office testing for strep, flu, pregnancy, etc.
- All other services not listed here i.e. prescriptions, outside lab tests, cultures, pap smears, radiology testing and specialty referrals will be the student's responsibility to pay.
- Any visit after 6 will be billed to the student's insurance or Mercy Health will assist with a fee for service schedule. 40% prompt pay discount available if paid in full at time of service.
- Office Hours: Monday - Thursday 8:00AM - 5:00PM (closed daily 12-1PM for lunch)
- Hours are subject to change. The health center is typically closed during long university breaks (Winter, Spring, Summer)
- Appointments encouraged but walk-ins are welcome
- Please bring with you to your clinic visit: government issued photo ID (driver's license), Wittenberg Student ID and insurance card. (Parent's should make a photo copy or request an additional card for student).
- If a specific pharmacy or laboratory is required by your private insurance, please be sure to share this with the clinic at the time of your appointment
