Planning for the course

- ☐ **CCUE 100 is a course and involves more than logging service hours.**
Civic engagement runs deeper than participating in service--it's about building community and learning about yourself. The course provides support and resources to prepare you for this experience.
- ☐ **Enroll in this course before junior year, when possible**
Take this course when your schedule is less demanding, preferably when you have less coursework or your sport is not in-season.
- ☐ **Make sure the course is scheduled, not planned**
Students must ensure this course is scheduled no later than Week 4 to allow completion of the course.

What to expect during the semester

- ☐ **You must attend 2 required meetings: an orientation and a reflection session**
Orientation & Service Fair takes place Week 2; Reflection Sessions (RAP) take place Week 10 and 11
- ☐ **We connect you with service sites in Springfield/Clark County**
During the service fair, we bring sites to campus so that you can find an option that works for you. Self-Design sites not on our list can also be proposed if they fit our service guidelines.
- ☐ **Each week of the semester, complete around 3 hours of service**
You set your schedule to serve along with your site, allowing flexibility around other commitments.
- ☐ **Complete assignments to help you stay on track and reflect on your experience**
This course requires a few short assignments that are completed through Moodle.
- ☐ **The Hagen Center is here to support students**
We are here to make sure your service experience goes smoothly, including troubleshooting with sites and connecting students with transportation when needed.

Completing the course

- ☐ **All service hours, required meetings, and assignments must be completed for credit**
Requirements must be completed during the semester a student is enrolled in CCUE 100

30 HOURS OF CIVIC ENGAGEMENT = **27** hours of direct service + **3** hours orientation & reflection

- ☐ **Seniors can be prevented from graduating if course is not complete**
Civic engagement is a requirement for graduation at Wittenberg so don't delay!
