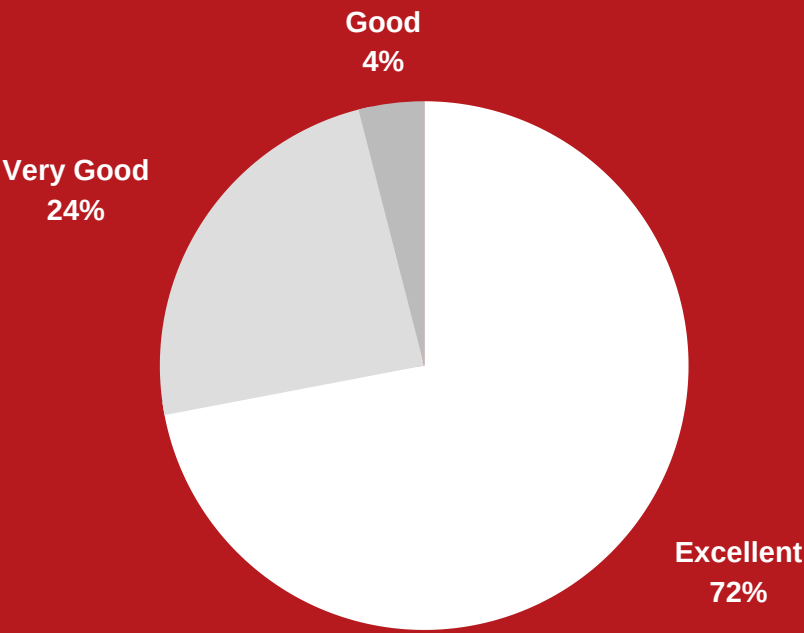

In the summer of 2019, students conducted internships across 3 countries, 11 states, and 34 different cities.



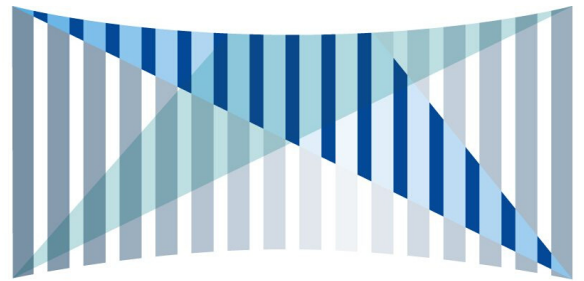
