Program requirements:		
General Education: Satisfactory completion of all general education requirements.		
Major:	Satisfactory completion of all requirements for a major in education (54 credits). To earn the Primary Education (P-5) licensure, 12 additional credits are required for a total of 66 credits.	
Electives: Additional electives, as needed, to meet graduation requirement of 126 credits.		

Requirements for Primary (P-5) Licensure:

Students are required to pass Student Teaching (EDUC 495) and earn a C- or higher in Student Teaching Seminar (EDUC 496) and earn a C- or higher in the course.
