- Successful completion of the Intervention Specialist (K-12): Mild-Moderate Licensure program allows candidates to apply for an Early Childhood License simultaneously.
- All courses must be passed with a grade of C- or above. See the Academic Catalog for additional requirements for admission and continuation in the program. Courses may not be offered every year. Check the department schedules for course offerings.
- Students are required to complete a capstone assessment, the edTPA, during their Student Teaching Seminar (EDUC-496) and earn a C- or higher in the course.
- Any change(s) in this program of study must be approved by the Chairperson of the major department and the Director of Assessment & Licensure, Wittenberg University.
