English Minor – 20 Credits

Of the 20 required credits in English, no more than two can be non-literature based

- ☐ ENGL 180: Themes & Traditions in Literature OR ENGL 190: Topics in World Anglophone Literature
- ☐ ENGL 270: Literary Form & Interpretation
- ☐ ENGL 280: British Literary Genealogies OR ENGL 290: American Literary Genealogies
- ☐ Eight credits at the 300-level, four of which must be a literature seminar course

Creative Writing Minor – 21 Credits

- ☐ ENGL 240: Beginning Creative Writing
- ☐ ENGL 406: Capstone in Creative Writing (1 credit)

Sixteen credits from the following:

- ☐ ENGL 340: Topics in Advanced Fiction
- ☐ ENGL 341: Topics in Advanced Poetry
- ☐ ENGL 342: Topics in Advanced Creative Non-Fiction
- ☐ ENGL 343: Topics in Advanced Screenwriting
- ☐ ENGL 344: Summer Screenwriting Institute
- ☐ THDN 240: Playwriting

All of the above sixteen credits cannot be in the same genre of creative writing; students must take four credits each in at least two different genres.

Journalism Minor – 20 Credits

- ☐ ENGL 320: Advanced News Writing OR ENGL 321: Advanced Feature Writing

Eight credits from the following:

- ☐ CMDM 351: Media Law
- ☐ CMDM 491: Internship (must be approved for minor)
- ☐ ENGL 320 or ENGL 321 (whichever is not taken for the core requirement above)
- ☐ ENGL 491: Internship (must be approved for minor)

Senior minors will also submit a portfolio of their journalistic work with a brief reflective essay.

Note: The creative writing minor and the journalism minor can both be taken in combination with an English major with two courses overlapping; the journalism minor could also potentially overlap two courses with a communication major.
