- The Employee Assistance Plan (EAP) is a no-cost, short term EAP service provided to Wittenberg employees and immediate family members and is contracted through LifeWorks U.S., Inc., a partner of MetLife. The program includes up to five telephonic or video consultations with licensed counselors per issue, per calendar year. Employees and their immediate family members can call 1-888-319-7819 to speak with a provider.
- Anthem's LiveHealth online offers online behavioral health visits at a cost of \$80 \$95 per visit (cost varies depending on the content of the visit).
 - To use <u>Anthem's LiveHealth Online</u> you must first "Sign Up" using your computer or download the <u>mobile app</u>.
 - Remember, dependents age 18 or above must create their own account as required by HIPAA.
 - Use the emergency room in emergency situations.
