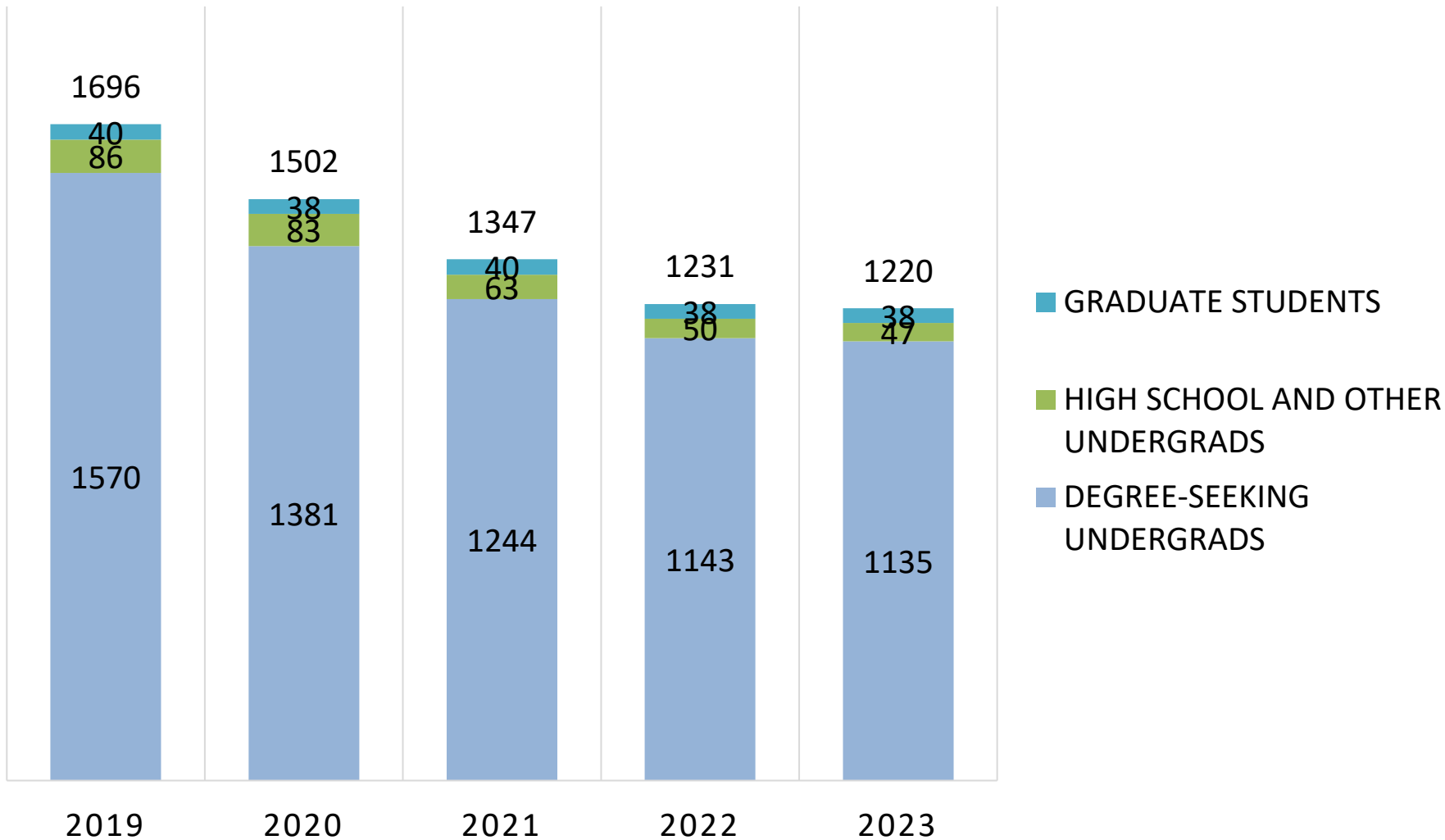

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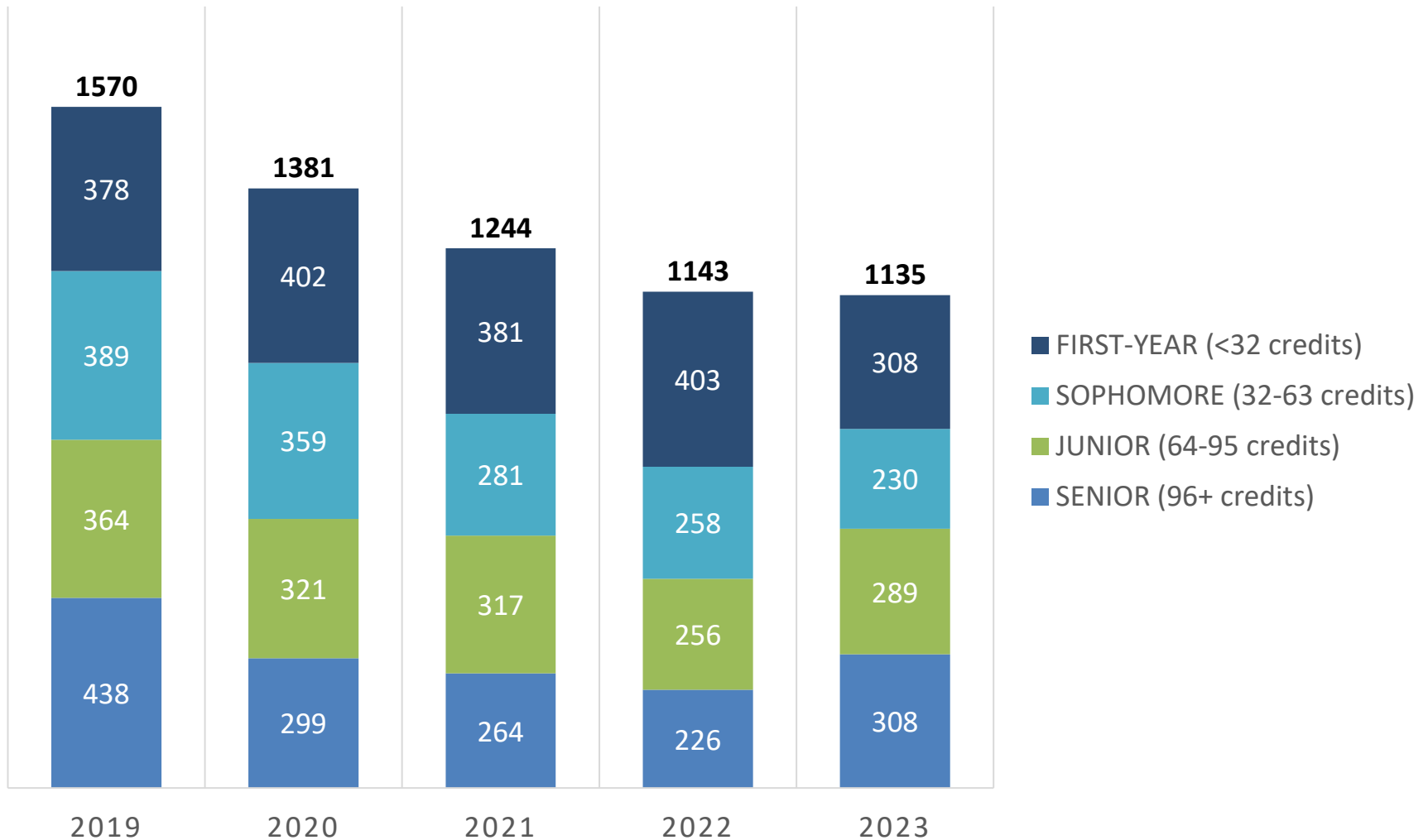

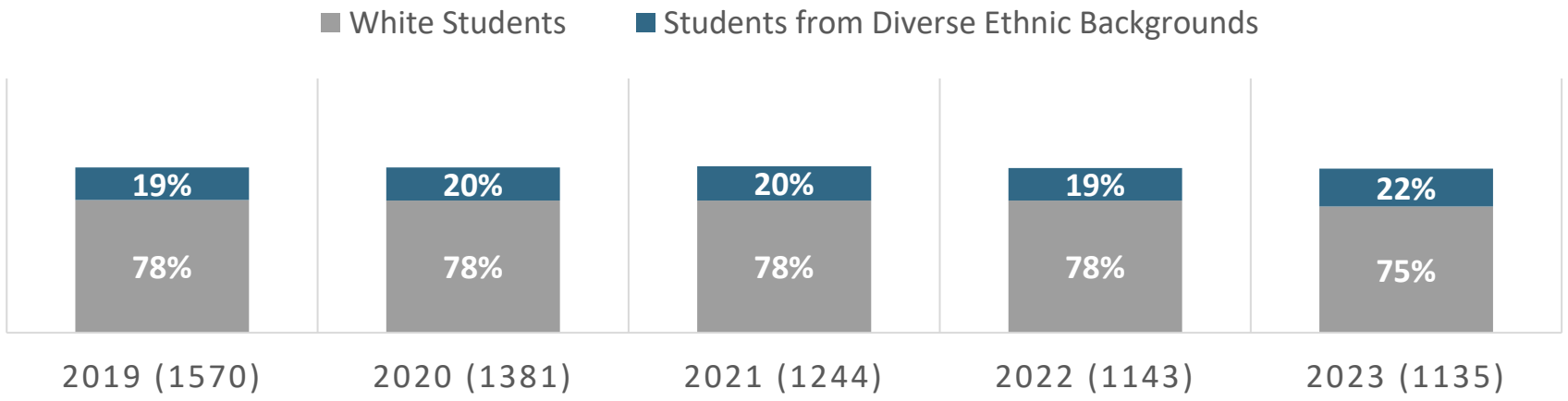
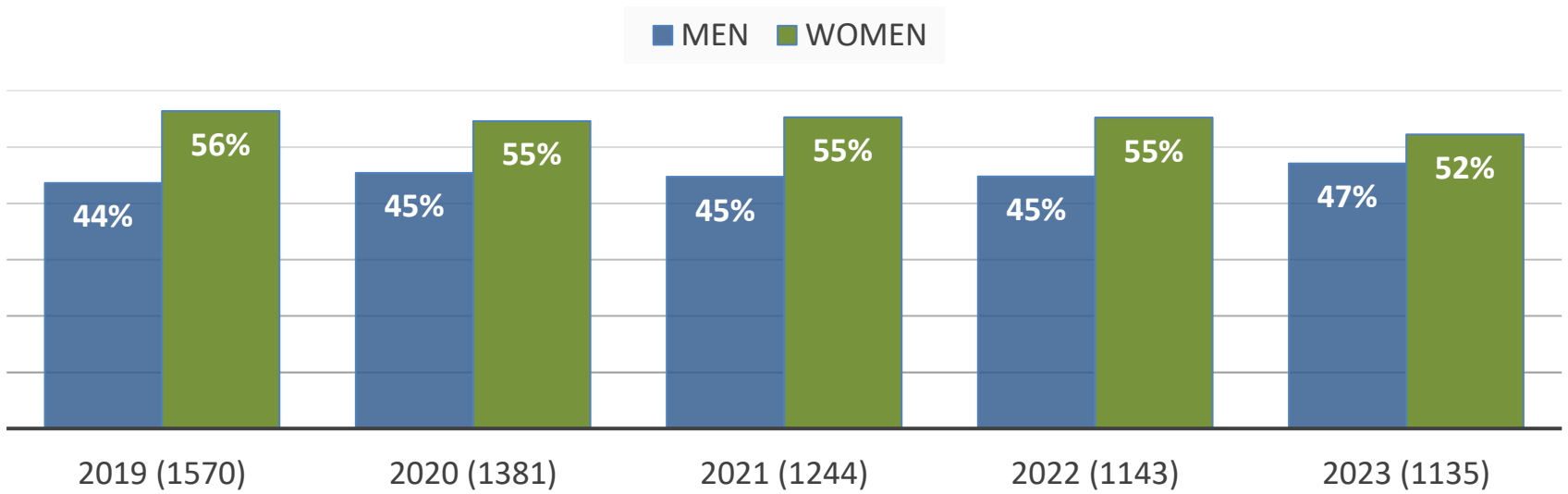
# Spring Enrollment By Level



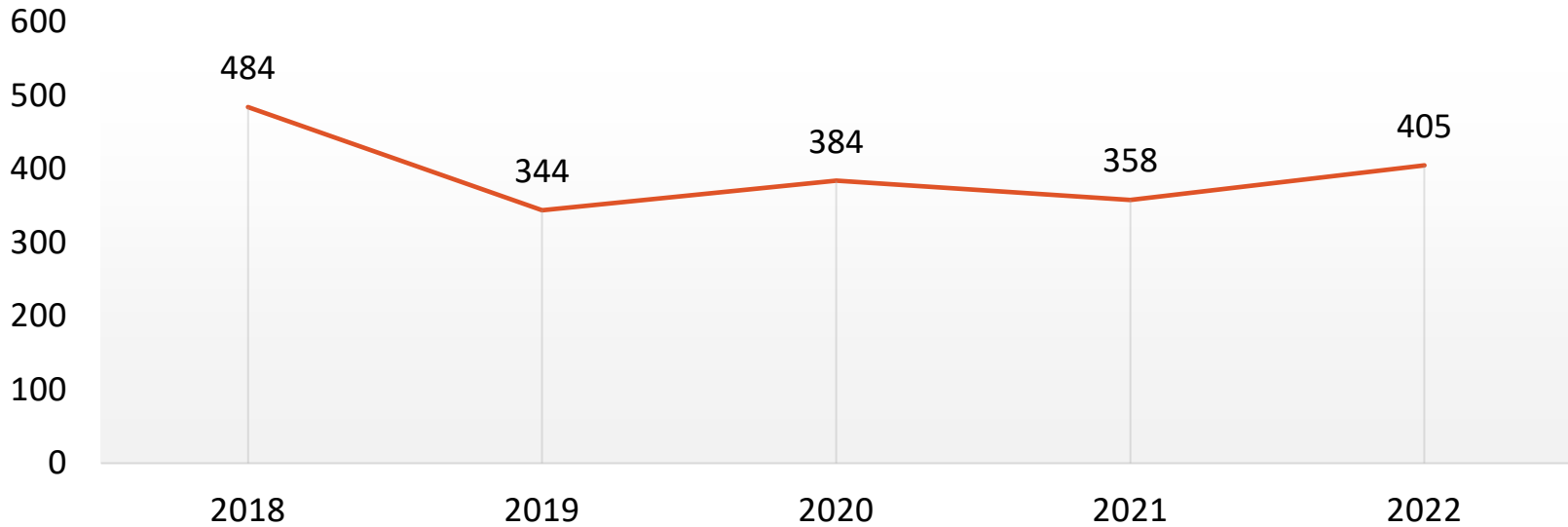
# Traditional Undergraduates By Class



# Traditional Students By Gender and Diversity



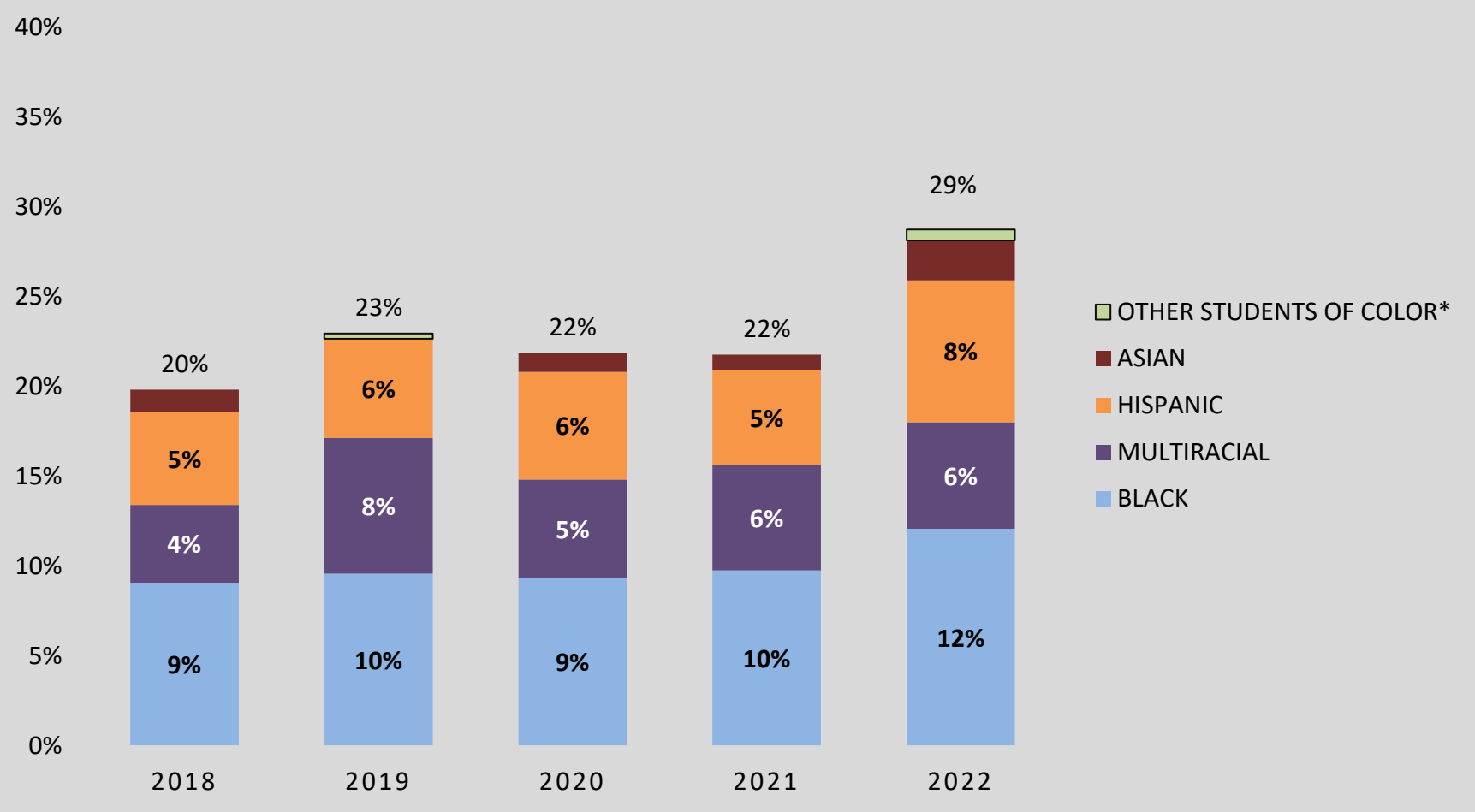
# Cohort: Wittenberg's First-Time, Full-Time Students



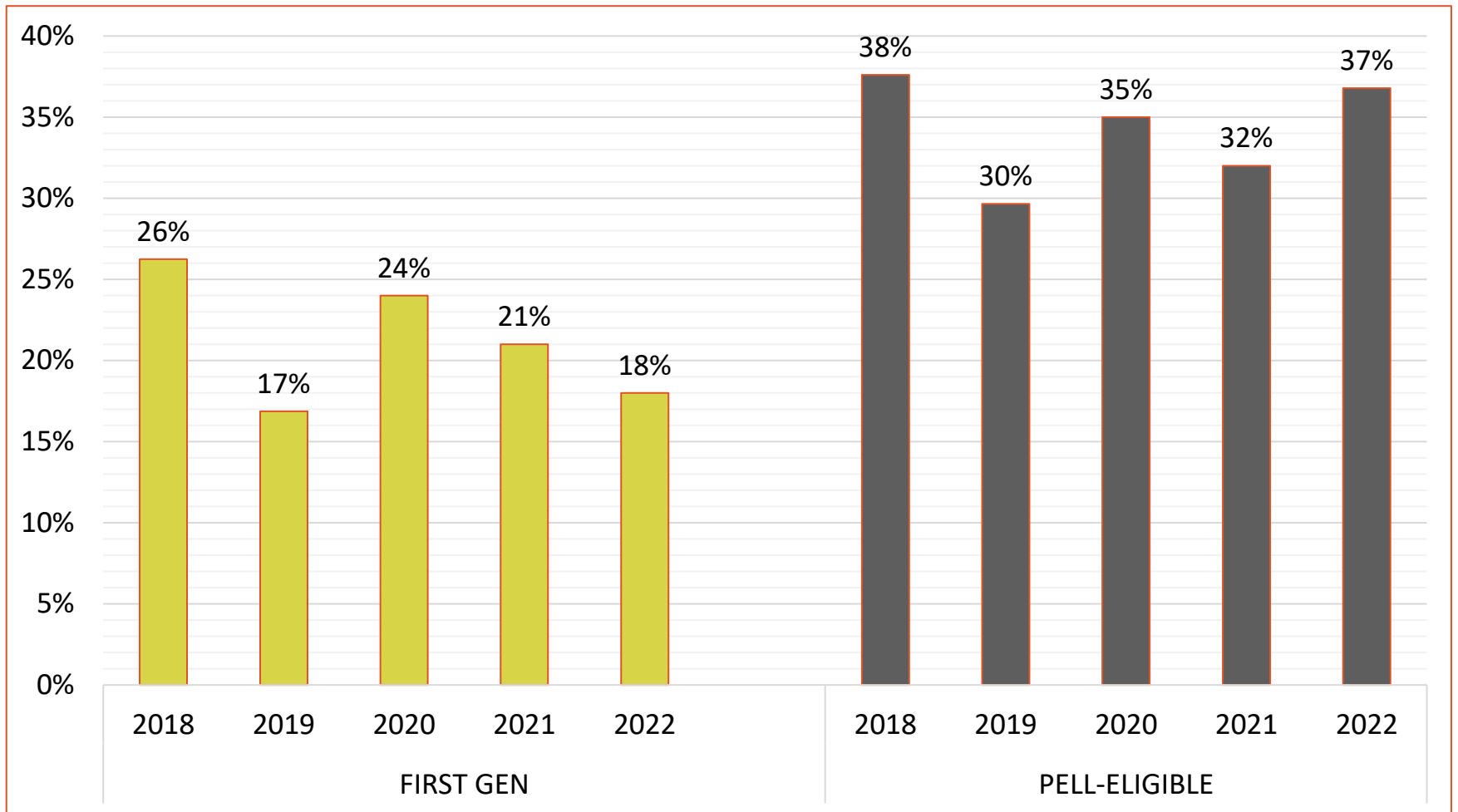
## The 2022 Cohort

- The Cohort is comprised of those entering students who are first time in college, full time, and degree seeking.
- 78% of the 2022 Cohort is from Ohio
- 49% are women and 51% are men
- 55% of the cohort are athlete-scholars
- The 2022 Cohort is the most racially and ethnically diverse cohort in Wittenberg's past ten years

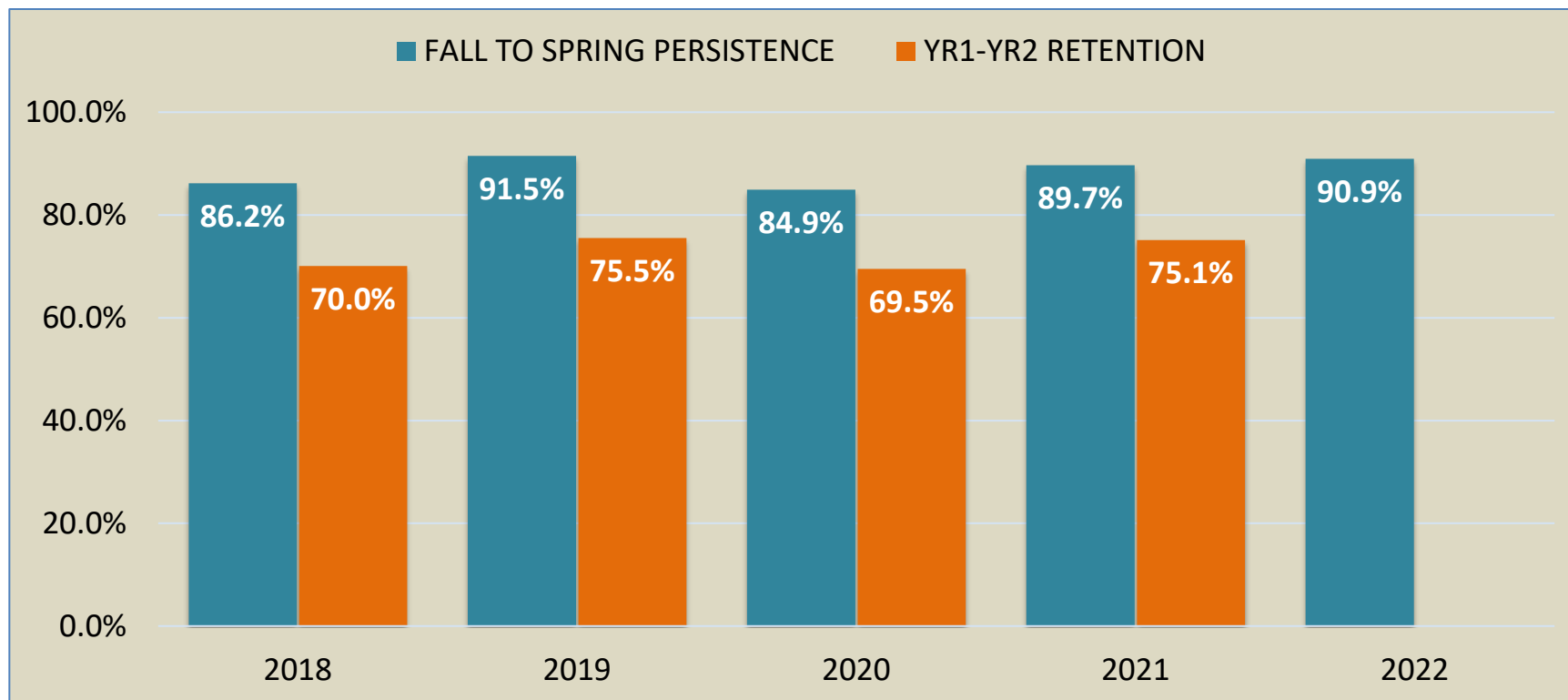
# Cohort: Percent By Race and Ethnicities of Color



# Cohort: First Generation and Pell-Eligible Students



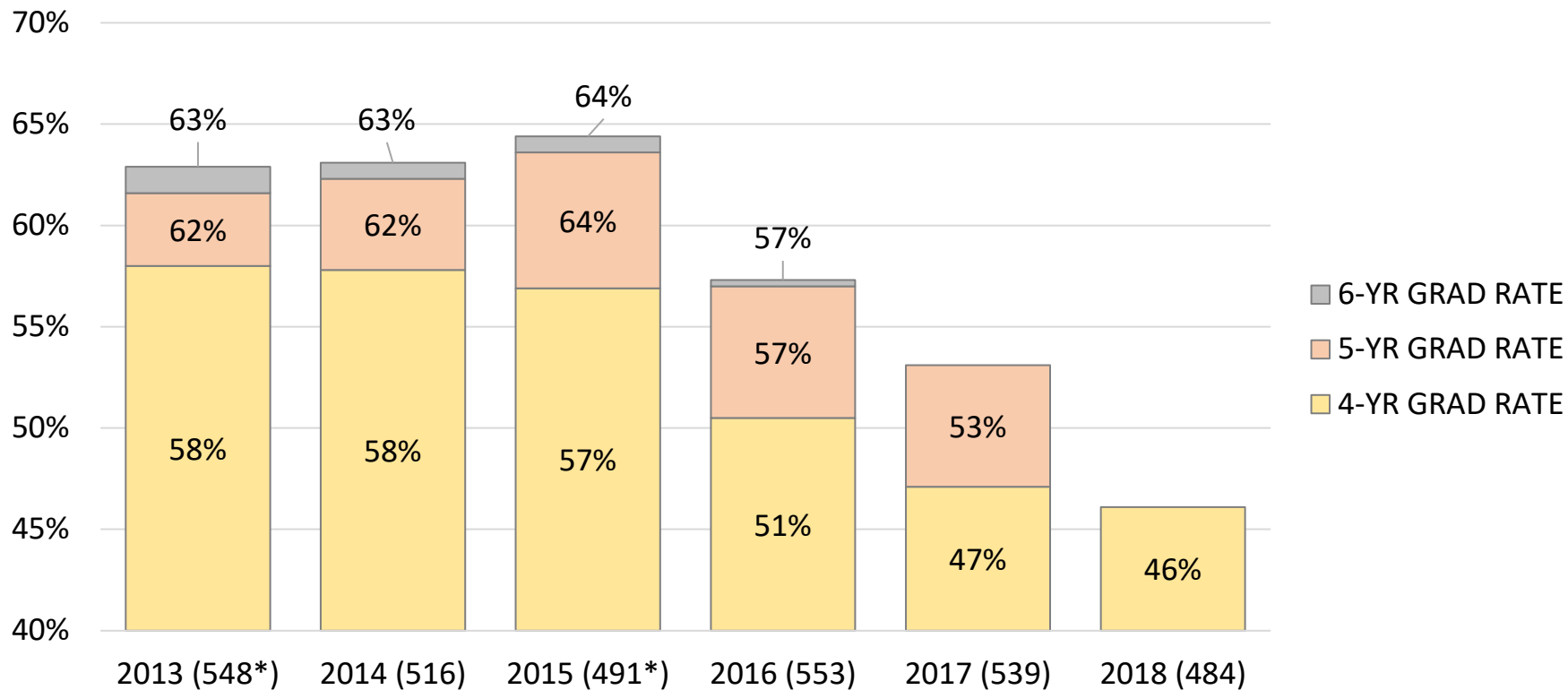
# Cohort: Persistence and Retention



- Fall to spring Cohort persistence is a leading indicator for first to second year retention
- Wittenberg's student success goals:
  - Persistence rate = 95%
  - Retention rate = 80%
  - Graduation rate = 70%



# Cohort: Graduation Rate



\* Note: Adjusted cohort number

- Wittenberg tracks graduation rates of the cohort at the 4 yr., 5 yr., and 6 yr. point
- The 6 yr. retention rate is used in many national benchmarking instruments such as IPEDS Peer Data Report and the US News rankings
