## CITI Training - Social and Behavioral Responsible Conduct of Research

The required course for submitting research petitions to the Institutional Review Board for Research with Human Subjects is the **Social and Behavioral Responsible Conduct of Research**.

All modules must be passed with at least an 80% pass rate. Any module can be take over until the required pass rate is achieved. The completion report showing module pass rates is submitted to the IRB along with the research petition materials. CITI certification is good for three years.
