

RENEWAL LOTTERY FAQ's

Can I renew my house for next year?

Check Your Wittenberg Email

Residence Life notified all current occupants in houses not currently eligible for renewal.

- Properties can only be renewed a maximum of 2 times before it is either removed from the available inventory or placed back into the General Housing Lottery.
- Some properties eligible for renewal could be restricted at a later date due to facility, departmental, and University needs.

Renewal can also be based on property treatment and conduct concerns.

How can I be sure I am ready?

1. Make sure your credits are correct

Any housemates with fewer than 60 credit hours, must be previously approved to live in the 'Burbs.

2. Clear any holds

You will not be allowed to proceed if any holds or restrictions exist; this will prohibit your entire group from entering preferences.

If a house does not get assigned through renewal lottery, it will be released to the general lottery.

If I renew, can I store belongings in my 'Burbs home over summer?

Only students that sign and pay for a summer housing agreement can keep belongings in Wittenberg housing.

All properties without a summer housing agreement will be cleared during the summer, including all basements and attics.

Any removal and disposal of belongings will be charged back to student accounts.
