(If you have less than a semester of college work, you may submit an unofficial transcript at the time of application, but will need to submit an official college transcript before you will be permitted to move to campus or begin classes.)
	Send official ACT or SAT scores (we are a test optional university)
	*Complete a Transfer Conduct Report from each college you have attended (you do not need to have one completed for a college at which only CCP classes were taken)
	Submit a FAFSA for your appropriate starting term
	If you are a current college athlete, please be sure to work with your current college to complete NCAA paperwork for transfer admission
	Submit your \$400 Enrollment Deposit
