| Scope: Wide focus; any significant emergency or dangerous situation. | Scope: Narrow focus; Clery Act crimes on Clery geography only. | Scope: Wide focus; any non-emergency situation that could impact personal safety and security; important, but does not fit into first- or second-tier group. |
| Why: Any significant emergency or dangerous situation occurring on campus involving an immediate/impending threat to health or safety of campus community members. | Why: Any Clery Act crime on Clery geography reported to a CSA or local law enforcement and considered a serious or continuing threat to the campus community. | Why: To provide information to campus community members regarding situations that could impact personal safety/security or cause large-scale concern to community members. |
| Where: Situations that occur on campus | Where: Clery crimes that occur on Clery geography. | Where: Focused generally on campus , but flexible enough to include situations occurring near campus that could impact our campus community. |
| When: Initiated immediately upon confirmation of the existence of the danger/emergency. | When: Issued as soon as pertinent information is available. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nature of the crime • Continuing danger to campus community • Possible risk of compromising law enforcement efforts | When: Varies. The situation may involve the need for an immediate notification while others may allow for a delay in the issuance to allow for greater detail/information to be provided. |
