- The Hanover document provides a good overview of strategies and benchmarks in strategic planning. Review before next meeting.
- The strategic plan needs to be a living, functioning document
  - o Be careful of wish lists vs. strategic plan
  - Some schools try to include entire campus, some schools are more project focused – more strategic and more likely to lead to an outcome, measurable and focused – what makes sense for Wittenberg?
    - Think we need a little bit of both
  - Planning horizon is typically 5 years (length of time that most institutions plan for
  - One pitfall is who monitors after the plan has been created IPBC can help monitor implementation of plan moving forward
- Would we consider a revised vision statement?

#### Steps

- Pete Hanson and Ty Buckman are in touch with a process consultant to help with public events on campus, provide advice
- Next week there will be a lunch and forum to introduce the UPC members and talk about processes
- Previous strategic plan took 3 years to develop (there was a Presidential transition)

- Will do environmental scanning audit of resources available on campus, look at peer institutions, gather feedback and ideas from community, sort through themes/projects
- Over the entire timeline of the project there will be multiple drafts following consultation and feedback – finished proposal for Feb. 2017 board meeting
