WHERE & HOW TO REPORT HAZING:

Because hazing activity is intended to be "underground" and unnoticed, it can be difficult to investigate. Reports of hazing can be made anonymously; however, it is very important to be specific about who is involved, what was observed, when and where the incident occurred – relevant and specific information.
