Article IV, Section 10, Letter C,

To provide for the selection of six (6) students to attend Faculty Meetings with full voice and vote. The Faculty-Student Coordinator and the Student Senate President shall be two of these members. The Faculty-Student Coordinator and shall appoint the other ~~five (5)~~ four (4) members at the final student senate meeting of the preceding semester.
