This guide walks you through the entire process of filling out your housing application for Wittenberg University. Learn how to select your building preferences, disclose immunization information, and indicate your living arrangements for the upcoming academic year.

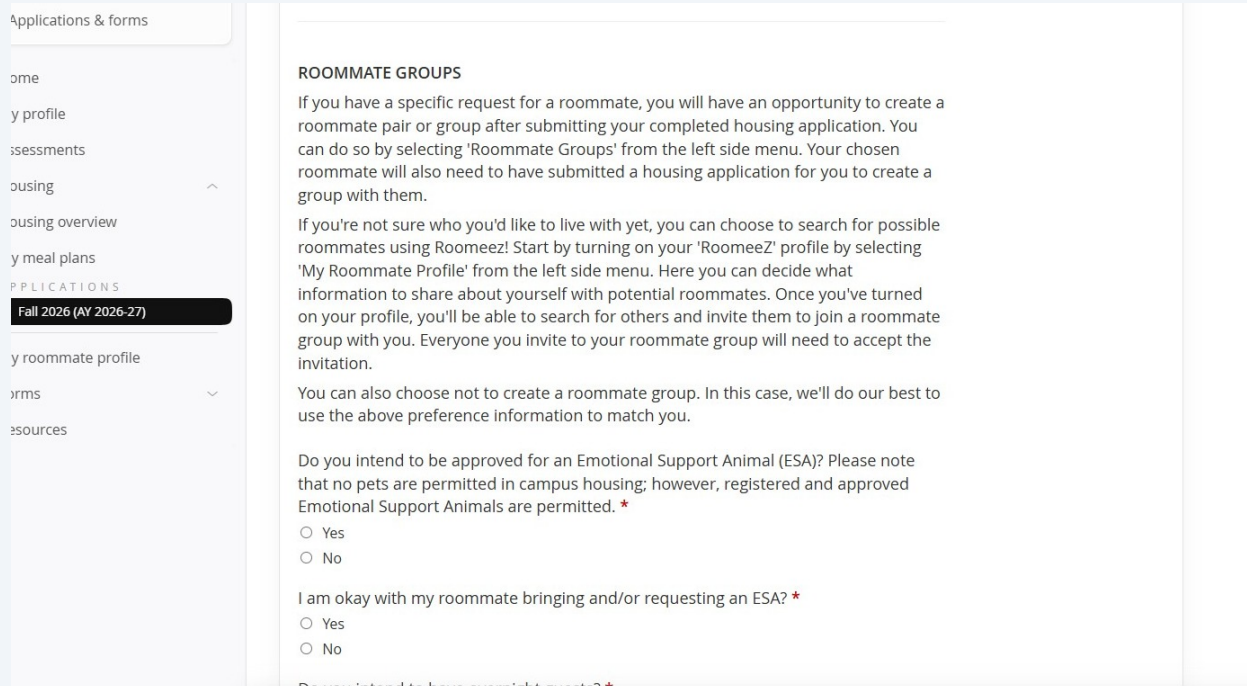

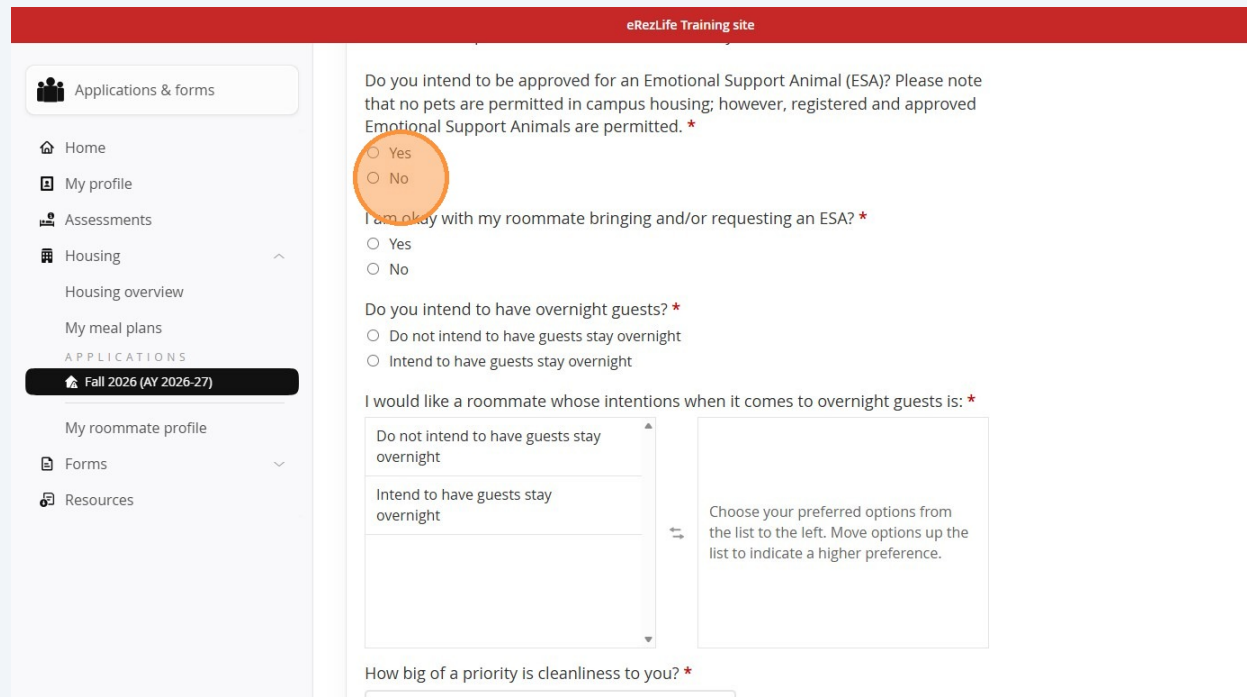
